Some criteria for the success

- Personal approach /same age, name, street, city,
- Create visibility / involve Media
- Use strong symbolic pictures / the invited surivors spoke from the balcony where Hitler spoke in 1939,
- Create a group identity / we act together, what are our values we want to transfer into our present and our future.
- Create the possibility to interact with larger groups of the population

Project in the Concentration Camp Memorial Mauthausen



- Field of light an hope around the concentration camp memorial in the night of silence.
- 1000 young people from 17 nations participated /survivors visited them
- Try to imagine to be a particpant, what would be your feeling, what would be your connected emotion

After a ceremony with survivors peace doves with a peace message were freed and flew into all directions





- Survivors, School children and all interested people are invited to bring the roses to the houses where the victims formerly lived
- 25.000 people participated / a lot more were inolved / the inhabitants of the houses, people seeing the installation during the day and night before, peple seeing the kids bringing the roses to the house doors.




A door with the roses in the 2nd district in Vienna

- More than 200 survivors from all over the world came back to Austria to visit Austrian schools
- The Austrian pupils were asked to remember the killed family members of these survivors with their creative aproaches / art works
- A huge exhibition on the Heldenplatz in Vienna showed some of this works
